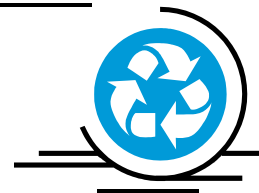
Thanks to those who continue to support PIP with their Shaw's Receipts! The process for collecting receipts has changed.

1. Go to the shaw's rewards site online- [www.shaws.com/neighborhoodrewards](http://www.shaws.com/neighborhoodrewards)
2. Enter the number on the back of your Shaw's card (all digits.)
3. Enter the phone number you used when you got your card (if you enter the wrong number, call customer service # on the screen.)
4. If the above numbers match you will be asked to enter the 11 digit organization number 49001018583
5. It should then say that your receipt rewards will go directly to the Parent Involvement Program.
